DISCUSSION GUIDE HARD CIDER By Barbara Stark-Nemon

- 1. Why do you think the author chose the title *Hard Cider*?
- 2. What are the family issues in *Hard Cider* that strike you most? What changes in the way we form families have occurred from the time Abbie Rose started trying to have children to the contemporary time when the novel takes place? What challenges do adoption, infertility and surrogacy present in this story?
- 3. How do the themes of fertility, growth, and expansion reveal themselves in *Hard Cider*?
- 4. Why do you think Abbie Rose persists in pursuing a business her husband doesn't fully support?
- 5. Discuss the themes of transformation and reinvention in this novel.
- 6. What role does setting play in this novel? Have you been to Michigan? Do you want to go visit now?
- 7. Were you familiar with hard cider before reading this novel? Have you ever tried it? Why does the author go into detail about the growing of the apples and the making of cider?
- 8. Abbie Rose is pursuing an encore career. Do you think it is now more common for women to pursue second careers?

- 9. Fiber arts are important to Abbie Rose. What does Abbie's knitting and quilting reveal about her character? How does it influence her life?
- 10. Why do you think Abbie Rose tried a tarot reading?
- 11. Discuss the labyrinth scene. Why is it important to the book?
- 12. What are the characteristics Abbie Rose has, as a parent, that help her? Do you think she succeeds as a parent? What role does emotional intelligence play in this novel?
- 13. What was your favorite scene?
- 14. What do you hope for Abbie Rose? What do you think she hopes for herself?
